2017 Chardonnay

VQA Niagara Peninsula

Varietals: 100% Chardonnay

Tasting Notes:

A medium bodied white with notes of crisp green apple and citrus on the nose. The palate displays pineapple, pear, honey and apple hints with a smooth mellow finish.

Food Pairing:

Enjoy with a traditional turkey dinner, a grilled chicken sandwich topped with apples and brie or with pasta in a light cream sauce.

Growing Season and Harvest:

Sourced from a selection of high quality Ontario vineyards. 80% of the wine was cool fermented and aged in stainless steel tanks, the remaining 20% was fermented and aged in French and American oak barrels for 6 months. Underwent malolactic fermentation and filtering before bottling.
